



Head Lice Policy

In the interests of the wellbeing of your daughter and others in the community, all community members will have their heads checked for head lice at check-in on Opening Day(s).

PLEASE CHECK YOUR DAUGHTER'S HEAD AT HOME BEFORE BRINGING HER TO CAMP.

If at check in, we discover “extra friends” we will ask you to treat your daughter off site (at home, in a hotel, etc.), and bring her back to camp **AFTER** one treatment and full comb out has been completed. Our experience is that treatments only work with careful combing as well and this takes time. We need our health care team and staff to be able to engage in pursuits other than combing! Laundry also must be done and that is a challenge for us at camp.

We will recheck upon your daughter's return to camp, and follow up with another lice check seven days after her first treatment.

For girls staying through a changeover, their heads will be rechecked before the new session begins.

If lice is discovered while your daughter is at camp, we will be touch with you about the plan of action! We do have treatment kits at camp that we can use if necessary.
